# MEMBERSHIP INFO

## MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION FOR MEN AND WOMEN

Guests may be signed in two (2) times then they are required to join.  
Individuals may be proposed for membership by men or women.

Members (men or women) will be **DROPPED FOR NONPAYMENT OF DUES**. Every member shall be in arrears after the expiration date of their dues. An expired member shall not be entitled to any privileges of membership, nor be considered a qualified guest. It is the member's responsibility to know the date of their dues will become delinquent. A member's failure to receive notice of their dues or arrearages shall not release them from their responsibility to pay their dues before the expiration date. A member in arrears shall be dropped from the rolls after the expiration of twelve (12) months.

The membership of a member no longer eligible for reinstatement will be marked at "terminated" after a period of twenty-four (24) months.

**PLEASE present your membership card when entering so the Bar Stewards can do their job. Our Lodge depends on you doing the right thing to keep our status and stay in business.**

There is not much to report with the lodge just opening.

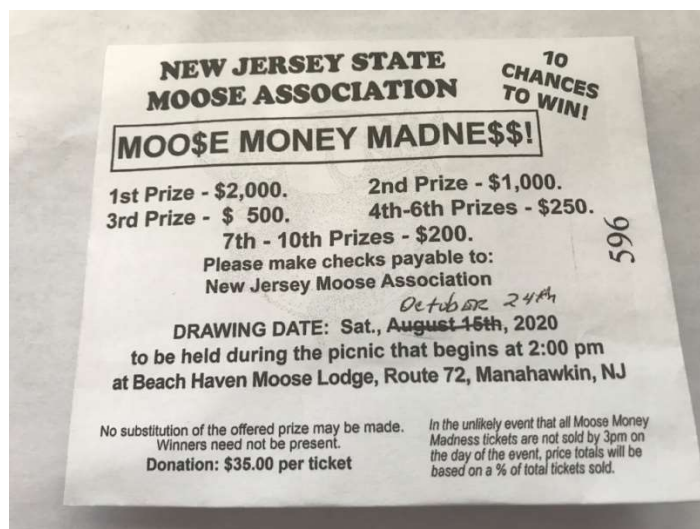
I do think we should start thinking about fundraisers s we can help our Lodge get back on its feet financially.
